

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULES

Illinois Energy Conservation Code Amendments

71 III. Adm. Code 600

These proposed amendments update the Illinois Energy Conservation Code from the 2015 International Energy Conservation Code (IECC) to the 2018 edition of the IECC.

Other modifications include:

- A revision to State funded facilities section. Per Public Act 100-0729, State funded facilities must now comply with the International Energy Conservation Code versus ASHRAE standards.
- Section 600.210 was revised to remove the variance process for state facilities as this is covered in the IECC and exemptions were added that are allowed for private commercial buildings.
- A few sections were rearranged or reworded to make the rules more consistent with statute and the 2018 IECC.
- Appendix A now references the Illinois specific amendments to the 2018 IECC versus the 2015. These amendments to the 2018 IECC are recommended by the Illinois Energy Conservation Advisory Council and include changes to the administration, definitions, and various technical sections related to building envelope; additions, alterations and repairs of existing buildings; alternative compliance methods; and ventilation requirements for residential buildings.

These rules are scheduled to be published in the Illinois Register to begin the rulemaking process in accordance with the Illinois Administrative Procedure Act. This page will be updated with a link to the Illinois Register when the proposed rules are published.
