### 9/20: LEED 260 – Daylighting and IEQ Credit 8.1 (1.5 BD+C, ID+C, O+M LEED Specific hrs)

This session will discuss the May addenda revisions to IEQ Credit 8.1: Daylight and Views—Daylight, and how these revisions are intended to help project teams earn the credit. Gain a deeper understanding of daylight best practices as our subject matter experts walk through examples and the available USGBC tools and resources. Upon completion of this webinar session, attendees will be able to articulate what changes were made to IEQc8.1, outline strategies for achieving the credit, and document credit achievement.

### 10/11: LEED 250 – LEED Pilot Credits: Acoustics (1.5 BD+C, ID+C, O+M, HOMES, ND LEED Specific hrs)

With so many detailed considerations and constraints in building design and construction, why would anyone add 'acoustics' to the list of concerns? We know that the positive impact of good acoustics in schools, but does it really matter in other building types? Many think that it does. The well-being, productivity and even the ability to effectively communicate can be hampered by bad acoustics. But the conversation of acoustics doesn't stop there. How many times has a meeting, or a good-nights-sleep been interrupted by outside noise? Acoustic design even impacts the exterior design of our home and other buildings. Through three LEED Pilot Credits, we explore strategies for high quality interior and exterior acoustical performance.

### 11/8: LEED 251 – Regional and Renewable Materials in LEED (1.5 BD+C, O+M LEED Specific hrs)

Interested in furthering your understanding of renewable and regional materials – and ways to successfully incorporate their use? This webinar is designed to teach individuals about strategies useful in meeting LEED requirements in various credit categories.

### 11/29: LEED 259 – Getting the Toxics Out: LEEDing the Way to Safer Materials (1.5 BD+C, ID+C LEED Specific hrs)

This session will provide a practitioner's guide to the new LEED Chemical Avoidance credits in the Pilot Library, what they accomplish, and how to achieve them. We will share with you practical strategies from the field for selecting safer, green, high performing products for your projects including what firms like Google, Kaiser, and Perkins+Will are doing to scrub chemicals of concern from product specifications and achieve the objectives of the new LEED pilot credits and beyond.
