

# NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULES OR AMENDMENTS

The amendments will better align rules related to delegation of authority to a municipality over 500,000 with the statute and other rules language which has been recently updated. The amendments will update the national technical codes incorporated by reference in these rules, which would impact the construction of new or upgraded underground storage tank facilities.
