Dear Vendor,

Effective January 1, 2023, the Capital Development Board (CDB) will require all new and renewing vendors that request either Architect/Engineer, Construction Manager/Program Manager, or Contractor prequalification to be an “Active (Accepted)” registrant in the Illinois Procurement Gateway System (IPG). The IPG will bring some efficiencies to the procurement process.

For new vendors to CDB, please see below information on the IPG system. For vendors renewing a prequalification, please be sure that you have an “Active (Accepted)” registration in the IPG prior to submitting your renewal information to CDB. CDB will continue to prequalify vendors for a three-year term provided the vendors maintain an “Active (Accepted)” registration in the IPG.
