ILLINOIS VETERANS' HOME AT QUINCY: Dedicated in 1886 and originally known as the Illinois Soldiers' and Sailors' Home, the Illinois Veterans' Home at Quincy is the largest and oldest veterans' home in Illinois. Often referred to as the city within a city, the campus sits on 210 acres and boasts its own post office, bank, museum, animal park, chapel, assembly hall, guest house and cemetery. The campus is a community providing veterans' housing ranging from domiciliary to skilled nursing care.
