

NOTICE OF INTENT TO USE THE SINGLE PRIME DELIVERY METHOD IN ACCORDANCE WITH PUBLIC ACT 99-0257

August 2, 2017

Pursuant to Public Act 99-0257, the Capital Development Board is hereby submitting written notice to the Procurement Policy Board of its intent to use the single prime procurement delivery method for this fifth determination to use the method under \$10,000,000. Included are the reasons for using the single prime method on this project and an explanation of why the use of the method is in the best interest of the State. Capital Development Board respectively requests approval for use of the single prime procurement delivery method on the project detailed hereafter.

General Scope of Work: This Military Affairs project provides for a building upgrade to the Adjutant General's Office (AGO) Building. Work includes a complete plumbing renovation throughout the existing building, a new building addition to allow for the provision of larger restrooms which will meet current ADA and plumbing codes, a new staircase to connect all floors of the building, renovations of existing small/outdated restrooms within key leadership offices, interior renovations to include an existing staircase and interior circulation, select interior demolition to include an interior staircase, interior restrooms, ceiling systems and corresponding HVAC systems. This project also includes the design of an updated elevator within the building. The project would include and provide for asbestos testing and abatement where required.
